SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

High School Seniors

The High School Senior Scholarships are designed to recognize students who have excelled in academics, leadership or technical education. Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application, admission application, and an **official** high school transcript before the deadline of *April 15*. Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis. Applications will be reviewed and awards made by the Reid State Technical College Scholarship Committee.

APPLICATION DEADLINE – April 15

An official transcript, application for admission and a scholarship application must be on file before a scholarship can be awarded.

Scholarship recipients must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours in the Fall and Spring Semesters. RSTC offers the Academic Honors, Leadership, and Need Based Scholarships as outlined below. Need Based Scholarships will be awarded based on high school GPA of 2.0 and enrollment in a technical program area and availability.

<u>Academic Honors</u> 3.0 or above High School GPA	Tuition for a minimum of 12 credit hours per term and continuing for the normal length of the selected program of study	3.0 GPA and successfully complete 24 credit hours per academic year
<u>Leadership</u> 2.5 or above High School GPA	Tuition for 12 credit hours per term and continuing for the normal length of the selected program of study	2.5 GPA and successfully complete 24 credit hours per academic year
<u>Need Based</u> 2.0 or above High School GPA and plans to enroll in a technical program of study	Tuition for 12 credit hours per term and continuing for the normal length of the selected technical program of study	2.0 GPA and successfully complete 24 credit hours per academic year
